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Recognizing that sustainability is a shared responsibility, Label Technology integrates eco-responsible solutions into all aspects of our business. Our goal is to implement sustainability practices that help reduce our carbon footprint and minimize our environmental impact.



99% of our printing is done with water-based inks which can be easily cleaned up using **soap & water**.



We use only environmentally-friendly **water-based adhesives** for our structure laminations.



In 2005, we converted to a **direct-to-plate** system which eliminated our need for film, along with the associated processing chemicals and by-products created during the film plating process: reducing waste by over **50%**.



We work with our customers to **optimize** their packaging in order to **minimize** potential waste factors.



We use state-of-the-art tension control systems that allow us to run very thin structures, enabling **source reduction** at the package level.



We work with our material vendors to promote eco-friendly materials with **post-consumer** waste content as well as compostable constructions created from **renewable resources**.



We have invested in advanced automatic registration and defect detection systems to **significantly reduce** production make-ready and run wastes.



We actively manage our waste stream with a plant-wide **recycling program** that places an emphasis on reusing materials wherever possible.



We also work with local recyclers to find appropriate processing facilities for our **waste materials**.
